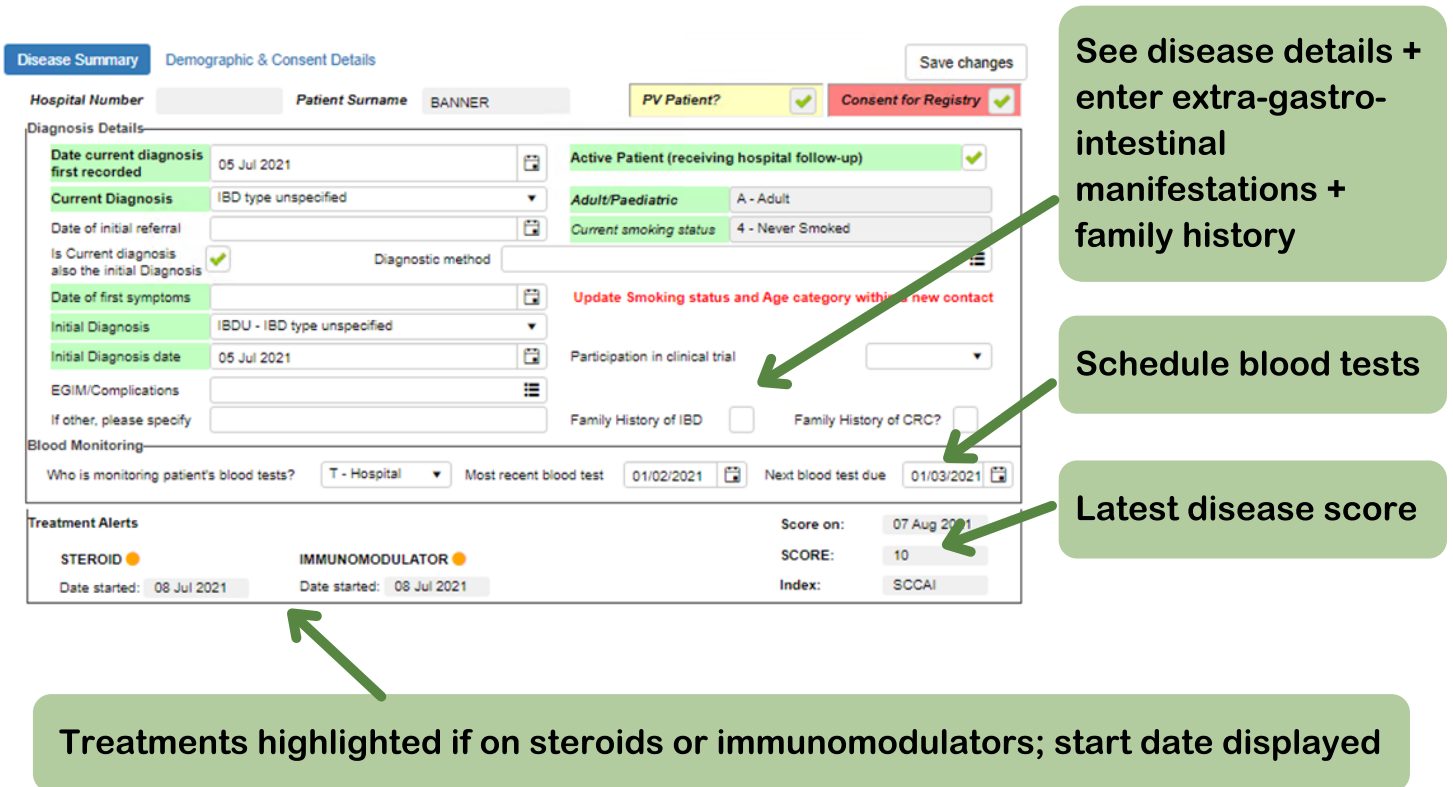


## Reviewing a patient – what’s on the Homepage

Logon

The Homepage is displayed after registering a new patient or searching for an existing one
